Closing Celebration: 1h45 to 2h00 pm

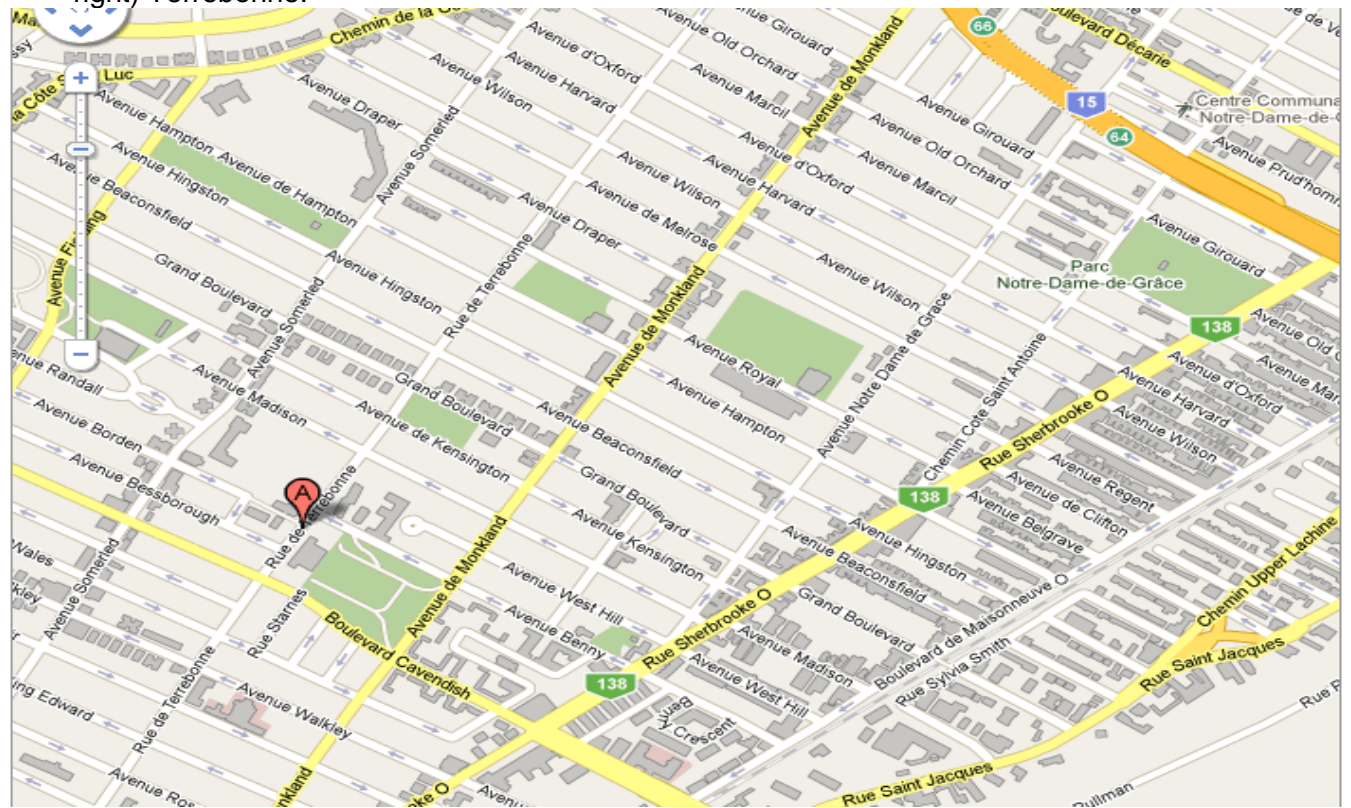
St. Monica's Church: 6405 Rue de Terrebonne, Montreal (N.D.G.)

*****Due to parking limitations on Terrebonne, please park on Ave Brassborough*** (see map)**

DIRECTIONS:

From Decarie (15 south): Exit on Sherbrooke/St. Jacques, west on (turn right) Sherbrooke, north on (turn right) Cavendish Blvd, east on (turn right) Terrebonne.

From West: Highway 20, exit for St.Jacques/Blvd. Angrignon (after Pont Mercier exit), continue east on (straight) St. Jacques, north on (turn left) Cavendish, east on (turn right) Terrebonne.





On Departure day:

Remember to bring: (1) Your **Medicare card (very important)**, (2) your **Medical Form (signed by parent or guardian)**, (3) your **CCS Data Form** AND (4) your **Final payment** (cheque or cash - if not fully paid yet)

What to Bring to Camp:

Medicare card (very important), sleeping bag, pillow, cold weather clothing (winter jacket, winter pants, snow shoes, long pants, joggers, sweaters, warm socks), toiletries (soap, shampoo, comb, brush, laundry bag, toothbrush, toothpaste, towels), flashlight, camera (optional), and **lots of energy** (not optional)! (See a more detailed list below).

***Although the cabins are fully insulated, please pack according to the cold weather and bring enough warm clothing. We will also be doing activities outside (weather permits) so good, warm winter gear is absolutely essential. (A couple extra pairs of warm socks would be a good idea!)

What NOT to bring to camp:

Cell phones, videogames, valuables, large sums of money, non-prescription drugs, alcohol, or weapons of any kind should not be brought to camp. **Campers who consume non-prescription drugs, alcohol or weapons at camp or are found in possession of them, will be sent home immediately (payment is non-refundable).** Inappropriate clothing is also strongly discouraged. Visions Camp provides a safe, fun, and friendly atmosphere, away from traditional urban influences. This also refers to avoiding bringing inappropriate beachwear attire and/or racist or derogatory slogans on t-shirts or other clothing. In essence, if you think that it does not fit in the theme of a Catholic camp for teenagers, then please leave it at home! Ipods are allowed in the cabins but not during activities.

SMOKING

No smoking is allowed during program at camp. If you do smoke and are under 18 yrs old, a smoking permission note (handwritten will do) is required on departure day - signed by parent or guardian.
